FIRST CONFESSION

Thank you!

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

All being well, and with no more unexpected restrictions or announcements form the Bishop or from the N.I. Executive, Holy Communion will take place on <u>Saturday 18th September @ 11.00am</u> at Derry Road Chapel. Numbers will be restricted to mum, dad, child and one other. Thank you.

CONFIRMATION

As above, all being well the Sacrament of Confirmation will take place on <u>Saturday 26th June</u> for our P7 pupils. Pupils will view the mass online at <u>10.00am</u> from the Parish Webcam. Pupils are asked to be seated at the Derry Road Chapel, at <u>11.45am</u> and the Anointing with Chrism will take place at **Noon**. Mum, dad, child and sponsor only when attending the Chapel. Thank you.

BOOK LAUNCH

Melmount Community Forum selected our school to launch a book entitled "Take Action, Make Change".

This is a free resource available from Melmount Community Forum. A group of young people from Melmount Community Forum came up with designing a book which would meet the needs of our young people.

If you discover that your child has been identified as a close contact, you **MUST** isolate your child until further notice. If a child or family member tests **POSITIVE**, the **ENTIRE** household **MUST ISOLATE**.
